- 2. Continued CPVFD monthly business meetings second Monday of each month; last meeting 13 Aug at the station.
- 3. 2500 gallon Port-a-Tank (PaT) arrived this month; this piece of equipment is critical for us in staging water at a fire scene, especially a structure fire as it enables MSFD Eng 1 to have a water source; operating procedure will be for Tender 960 to ferry water for the PaT.
- 4. GSA wildfire equipment and PPE arrived; thanks to the Forest Service for placing this order for us.
- 5. Communications pagers have been distributed to the Department members providing ability to respond to MSFD dispatched calls.
- 6. Department "Emergency Recall Roster" created and in service.

- 7. Received a donated computer from El Paso County E-911 service; CPVFD volunteers donated the monitor, printer and other piece-parts.
- 8. Continue to support MSFD emergency response calls; most recent calls were Mutual Aid request by MSFD that dispatched CPVFD for Waldo Canyon smoke investigation; FF Collins supported MSFD during a house fire in Manitou Springs per our contract with MSFD.
- 9. CPVFD supported the HOA Annual Meeting where the Department kicked-off its initial T-Shirt fundraiser; special thanks to Peggy Beranek who donated \$100 to the Department Volunteer Fund.
- 10. CPVFD recently released the Crystal Park Evacuation Plan (EP) at the HOA Annual Meeting (additional copies are available in the CP Office); the EP represents another element of the CWPP that has been completed.
- 11. Continued to attend the El Paso County Chief's Forum and MSFD Monthly Business Meeting; in July, FF Hennessey was the recipient of a MSFD letterman's jacket for being on 35 fire calls.
- 12. Continued working with Ft Carson for helo evacuation procedures from the Upper Park landing zones; Ft Carson recently landed at LZ Cone and LZ Lake for initial landing tests which were successful; continue to work with Flight for Life (Penrose) and received landing zone lighting kit.



## 13. Upcoming Events:

- a. Joint Force Exercise (JFX) being planned between MSFD and CPVFD that will exercise response to a vehicle accident requiring high angle rescue, medical, vehicle extraction and fire capability.
- b. "CPVFD Town Hall" is projected for October
- c. CPVFD "I SUPPORT" Fundraiser will continue through next few months; T-shirts on sale in the CP Office
- d. September reconfiguration of Brush 940 back to snowplow status
