- 1. Incidents: For July, there were 7 total toned out calls. We had 3 move-up calls for potential flooding in Manitou Springs where the CPVFD is part of the MSFD Incident Action Plan (IAP) and we responded to a medical call while performing this function. We had an additional automatic aid cover assignment while MSFD worked an active structure fire where we responded to a gas leak. We also had one smoke investigation for the month that was unfounded. CPVFD volunteers continued to support numerous other calls in Manitou Springs this last month to help maintain our proficiency as a Fire•Rescue•EMS organization.
- **2. Grant Update:** The portable pump has been received and we should be looking to close out the VFA grant before the end of August
