

CRYSTAL PARK FIRE DEPARTMENT NOVEMBER 2013 MONTHLY UPDATE

1. Incidents: For November, there were 4 total toned out calls that were documented. CPFD volunteers continued to support numerous other calls in Manitou Springs this last month to help maintain our proficiency as a **Fire**•**Rescue**•**EMS** organization.

2. Grant Update: We submitted one grant to FEMA AFG for 4000 feet of supply line fire hose and 5 new nozzles. In December we will submit one more grant request for a new Type 6 brush truck.

3. Joint Training w/ Manitou Springs Fire Department: The CPFD and Manitou Springs FD conducting joint training associated with pumper operations, relay pumping between both department apparatus based on our SOPS, fire hydrant ops, and attack line deployment. In addition, we introduced new SOP associated with HAZMAT incident involving a propane tank fire and suppression techniques.



4. New "90-90-30 Initiative" Planned: There a new statewide initiative getting traction that we are trying to fight out more details regarding wildfire response. It is called the "90 90 30" or "Broken Arrow". This initiative is focused on getting 90 firefighters and 30 apparatus to any Wildland incident in the front range in 90 minutes. It is the intent of the CPFD to participate in the initiative as we may benefit from its implementation. In addition, it provides us opportunity to support real world incidents as part of this state initiative as we have already done under USFS red card deployments but possibly without the red card requirement.
