## <u>Crystal Park Volunteer Fire Department (CPVFD) Monthly Update</u>

Reviewed update provided by CPVFD Chief Welsch – discussions ensued. Joan will follow up with Chief on budget limits of CDFPC.

## **Grant Updates**

1. E.M.T.S. grant of \$63,240 was awarded for a department Ambulance, with a 10% match requirement (for a net amount of \$56,916). CPMD will need to fund up to \$6, 324, depending on the final purchase price of the Ambulance. Currently researching vehicles.

2. E.M.T.S. grant of \$18,000 was awarded for new Radios, with a 10% match requirement (for a net amount of \$16,200). CPMD will need to fund up to \$1,800, depending on the final purchase price of the radios.

**VOTE**: Joan made a motion to move forward on the purchase of the radios; Derek seconded; approved unanimously.

3. C.D.F.P.C. grant of \$19,848 was awarded for Bunker Gear. No match required.

It was noted that Steve received 10 oxygen bottles and 2 medical equipment boxes (at no cost) from Fort Carson.

Steve needs a letter from CPM Board and/or Chief stating that we want to be a part of the program to receive Fort Carson equipment (e.g., 4WD ambulance)

The Board assumes that our bid for a Timberwolf was not accepted, although we've received no correspondence from FEMA to that effect. We'll remove reference to this grant until something changes.

### **Old Business:**

- Vectra credit card policies were discussed. Researching policies, notifications, etc.
  Need to get policy information to Archie. No decision was made, no vote needed.
- Lawyer for Metro District: Need to identify an attorney as the 'go to' person (no retainer); Clint to speak with Linda Glesne
- Insurance Discussion:
  - o Russo is gone; new account is Kelly Saunders CB Insurance
  - Concern that Auxiliary members have liability coverage but are not covered by Workman's Comp; do we change bylaws such that Auxiliary are covered? (Associates are department members, they vote, pay dues, come to meetings); no decision made, no vote taken.

#### **New Business**

• Insurance Renewal: Reviewed values and annual fees for each vehicle; some minor corrections (to insurance policy) are required

**VOTE**: Joan moved to renew insurance with CB Insurance and pay the premium; Kathi seconded it; All in favor.

### **Compliance Calendar:**

Next year's budget needs to be approved at October Board meetings. Early draft of 2016 Budget was presented by Clint and discussions ensued:
