

2009 CPVFD Goals

- 1. Increase force strength by two (2) additionally trained Basic Firefighters; two (2) Engineers; and one (1) additional EMT-B
- 2. Mount the Port-a-Tank on Tender 960 NLT April 09
- 3. Execute procurements for AFG 2008 grant equipment and submit another AFG grant for Brush Vehicle; Rescue Gear (Extrication); and 3" Hose
- 4. Install Dry Hydrant #2
- 5. Sustain HOA and MD budgets at current levels
- 6. Each volunteer acquire one Class B shirt with badge, accoutrements and name tag NLT next major CP event
- 7. Submit two (2) additional grants beside AFG
- 8. Conduct four (4) CPR classes achieving 100% CPR/AED capability
- 9. Successfully execute three (3) fundraising events raising \$3000.00
- 10. Each Firefighter, Engineer, EMS (Active & Associate) achieve minimum 50 hrs of volunteer service to the good of the Department
- 11. Each Firefighter, Engineer, EMS (Active & Associate) attend at least one additional Professional Development training course
- 12. Conduct at least 20 Firewise assessments within the District
- 13. Execute 100% equipment inventory NLT March 09
- 14. Conduct NFPA compliance PM on equipment (i.e. ladders, pressure test, flow)
